

Based on Article 23 of the Law on Personal Data Protection ("Official Gazette of the Republic of Serbia", No. 87/2018 - hereinafter: the Law), fulfilling the duty of the controller as a legal entity towards you, as the person from whom data relating to you is collected, at the time of collection we provide you with the following:

NOTICE
about information provided when personal data is collected
from the person to whom it relate

(persons submitting a request for research of archival materials in the Historical Archives of Sombor)

1. Data on the controller: Historical Archive Sombor, Sombor, Trg cara Lazara no. 5, telephone number 025/ 412287, e-mail address: info@arhivsombor.org.rs
2. Data on the person responsible for personal data protection: Silvia Kovačević, archivist, telephone number 025/ 412287, e-mail address: info@arhivsombor.org.rs
3. Purpose and legal basis for the intended processing: Historical Archive Sombor collects data from persons who submit requests for research of archival materials for the purpose of protecting archival materials (cultural property), in accordance with Article 40 of the Law on Archival Materials and Archival Activities.
4. Data on the recipient, or group of recipients of personal data: none.
5. Information on the intention to transfer personal data to another country or international organization: the data will not be transferred to another country/international organization.

In addition to the information above, we provide you with additional information at the same time, i.e. at the time of collection of data relating to you, which may be necessary to ensure fair and transparent processing of such data, as follows:

- 1) retention period of personal data collected by researchers: permanently.
- 2) as a person of whom and from whom personal data are collected, you have the following rights:

- the right to request access to the data from the controller, in accordance with Article 26 of the Law,
- the right to rectify or delete your personal data in accordance with Art. 29 and 30 of the Law,
- the right to restriction of processing in accordance with Article 31 of the Law,
- the right to data portability in accordance with Article 36 of the Law,
- the right to object in accordance with Article 37 of the Law,
- the right, in accordance with Article 82 of the Law, to file a complaint with the Commissioner for Information of Public Importance and Personal Data Protection, if you believe that the processing of your personal data has been carried out in violation of the provisions of the Law;

Note: The provisions on the rights of data subjects under Articles 26 and 29 and Articles 31 to 37 of the Law do not apply if the processing is carried out for the purpose of archiving in the public interest, if it is necessary for the achievement of that purpose or if the application of those provisions of the law would make its achievement impossible or significantly difficult, with the application of the measures referred to in paragraphs 1 and 2 of Article 92 of the Law.

3) Obligation to provide personal data: The Historical Archive of Sombor is obliged to obtain your personal data in order to fulfill its legal obligation to protect archival materials.

4) Data protection: The Historical Archive of Sombor protects personal data in accordance with the Personal Data Protection Law.

Note: The user is liable for any violation of the right to personal data protection resulting from the use and publication of archival materials, in accordance with the law.
